A Letter

FROM OUR CEO



Hello, IMGNI Life fam!! With the sun rising early and setting late and the temperature optimal for outdoor activities – like walking, running, riding a bike, swimming – we hope that you are taking advantage of the beautiful days during these summer months.

Let me start by taking a moment to express our deepest gratitude for your incredible generosity to close out 2023, sustaining us halfway into 2024. Thanks to your contributions, we were able to renovate our clinic and expand programs & services that reach more abortion-vulnerable in our community. Over the last year, we've had 360 lives spared from the violence of abortion; 180 women that didn't have to live with the regret of an abortion & 180 babies that got to take their first breath. Your investment and partnership in this life-affirming work continues to make a huge difference and we just wanted you to know how much it means and know that we couldn't do it without you.

Over the years, it's been common for us to face a \$30,000 deficit going into the final quarter of the year, and every year (without fail) the Lord has covered that need. However, 2023 was a difficult year financially for many, us included. We were facing a deficit well over \$100,000 which I thought was insurmountable. But once again, the Lord came through in unexpected ways, down to the very last day of the year, getting us within \$100 of our fundraising goal for the year. Praise the Lord!

The account of Mary's unplanned pregnancy from Luke 1 comes to mind, (v.30) where Gabriel says to Mary, "Do not be afraid, for you have found favor with God". I feel that the Lord is saying, "Don't be anxious about finances, IMGNI Life and partners have found favor with Me...I will meet your needs...(v.37) For nothing will be impossible (or insurmountable) with God."

Once again, thank you from the bottom of our hearts. Your generosity continues to spare lives and foster a culture of life in our community.

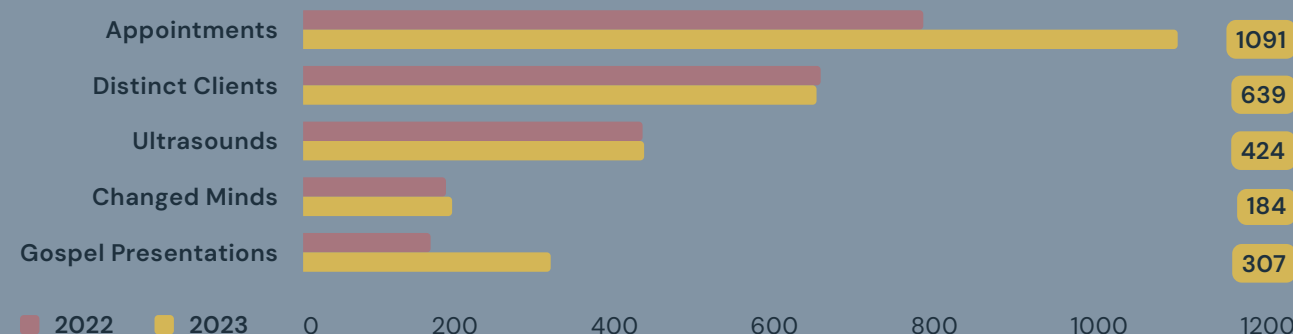

With your support, our medical pregnancy center was able to serve 639 distinct clients with 1091 appointments in 2023!

We provided 424 ultrasounds and presented the gospel to 307 clients. The efforts to empower those facing unplanned pregnancies with hope and life-affirming choices directly resulted in 184 changed minds.
